

EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP OF COCHIN AND PEKIN BANTAM

Savigliano (CN) 13-14 January 2018

Regolament

Article 1

The Italian Club of Cochin and Pekin Bantam organizes the European Championship of Cochin and Pekin Bantam. The event will take place at the polyphonic wing of Via Della Pace 301 in the municipality of Albissola Superiore (SV) – Italy.

Article 2

The organization and management of the event is organized by the Italian Club of Cochin and Pekin Bantam based in Cervasca (CN).

Article 4

They can exhibit at the European show of Cochin and Pekin Bantam all breeders of the of Cochin and Pekin Bantam breeds of European countries belonging to EE. In accordance with the federal and social contributions for the year 2017. Exhibitors should be exempt from disciplinary measures in their favor. Breeders must submit the application form within the date, duly completed. Animals should be in line with health standards.

Article 5

At the European exhibition, chickens of the following breeds can be exposed: Cochin and Pekin Bantam. All the poultry recognized by the European standard of avian breeds can be exposed to the European exhibition. The aforesaid poultry must have only the Federal Recognition rings, which are no-removable and specific to the breed, as provided by the European Standard. Inside the event will be set up a separate space for the free exchange of subjects not in the judgment of the Cochin and Pekin Bantam.

Article 6

Within the European Championship of Cochin and Pekin Bantam , the "Individual Competition" (European Champion) and the "Collection Competition" (Europameister) are invited.

The "Individual Competition" can be registered for animals born in the year 2017 – 2016-2015-2014-2013. Within the "Individual Competition" the following awards are planned:

European Champion title for any color present with more than 20 subjects. In the event that more than 40 subjects are present in a stain, the European Champion title is assigned to the best male and the best female exposed. European Champion Qualifiers are awarded on condition that the subjects have obtained the very good predicate (score 95 points).

All colors that do not reach the minimum number of 20 subjects compete for the attribution of a single European Champion title. The European medal is attributed to the best subject of any exposed breed (Cochin and PekinBantam).

In the "Collection Competition" can be registered animals born in the year 2017 – 2016-2015-2014-2013. Within the "Collection Competition" is the following awards: Europameister titles for collections represented by 4 subjects (2 males and 2 females) of the same breed and of the same color which have obtained a total score of 376 points. The subjects participating in the Europameister contest must be listed on the application form.

All European champions receive an attestation.

Article 7

Exhibitors will be required to participate in general and secretarial expenses with a contribution as follows:

Registration fee for each individual breeder €15,00.

Euro 5,00 for each animal registered to judging.

Euro 3.00 for each animal registered not to judging.

The registration fee **must be paid no later than 18 December 2017** by bank transfer to **Cepollina Simone** Iban **IT39B0306949431100000017137** BIC **BCITITMM** (San Paolo Institute of Turin Corso Europa 1 - 17025 Loano (SV)).

The contribution is also for to the animals registered and not received.

Article 8

Application forms, written on an attached form, must be sent to clubitaliacocincina@libero.it or by ordinary mail at the address Cepollina Simone Via Piste 9/1 - Loano (SV) **no later than 18 December 2017**. Entries will not be accepted after the deadline stated. The application form must be drawn up in its entirety and reflect the terminologies, races and colors provided by the European Standard. Animals not responding to this declaration will be rejected at the time of submission with charge of secretarial expenses.

Article 9

Cages will be made available by O.C., who will arrange the seats and the maintenance of subjects with commercial feed.

Article 10

The O.C. declines any responsibility for any thefts, leaks, deaths or "stress" illnesses and similarities that have been contracted during the event. Wounded or sick animals will be removed and placed in an appropriate space to receive the appropriate care, after hearing the health care counselor's opinion.

Article 11

The cages will be thrown at the end of the judgment and reopened only for the sneak or for the retreat of the subject placed in the sale or isolated in the infirmary.

Article 12

It is forbidden to place labels or other marks on the cages of the contestants by breeders

until the end of the judgment.

Article 13

Judicial proceedings will be carried out by Federal, Italian and Foreign Judges, designated by O.C. of the exhibition. The judgments will be expressed with the predicates envisaged by the European Standard. Individual Champion titles are awarded by an international jury. In cases where the court has its own pet animals who are candidates for the assignment of the individual European Champion title, it can not be part of the international jury.

Article 14

During the judgment, it will be forbidden to the public and exhibitors to stay in the exhibition venues. Only service personnel may be present.

Article 15

The O.C. of the exhibition is entitled to check the rings of the winning persons who must belong to the exhibitor, in the judgment and before the title is assigned; In case of irregularities the exhibitor will be excluded from the awards.

Article 16

The veterinary service is provided by the A.S.L. of Cuneo. All animals must come from areas declared free of infectious and diffuse diseases. When swallowing, the exhibitor will have to deliver Mod 4 according to the current guidelines and, in any case, reporting the vaccination against Newcastle. A vaccination certificate, issued by a veterinarian, or the vaccine purchase invoice, accompanied by an affidavit signed by a witness, is obligatory. Birds from the EU, Great Britain and Switzerland must have a sanitary certificate for intra-community exchange. The O.C. of the exhibition, having heard the opinion of the health care staff, can refuse the ingenuity of subjects arriving in unfulfilled health, with the obligation to contest the enrollment fees.

Article 17

Exhibitors wishing to surrender their subjects are invited to indicate it on the bidding card and must take into account that O.C. will hold, in the event of a sale, 15% of the stated price. Care will be taken by O.C. secretariat of the exhibition to follow the assignment to other breeders with accountancy to the owner at the time of the sale. Captured subjects may be withdrawn not before 12.00 o'clock on Sunday and preferably at the end of the event. Subjects who are not judged may be retired at any time of the event.

Article 18

Upon submission of the application, the exhibitor undertakes to accept and comply with all the rules contained in this regulation.

Article 19

Except as expressly provided in this Regulation, reference is made to the provisions contained in the General Regulations of E.E.
